



Enduring Perseverance Part III

(How to Persevere?)

Perseverance: *hupomoné*; remain under. A bearing up under circumstances and trials patiently, peacefully, with joyful hope.

The opposite meaning of “*hupomoné*” is: indignation; anger, wrath.

How to Persevere? A Series of Poems Need to be Written About Your Life (2 Corinthians 3:2–3)

Perspective: **A poem about your Perspective on life**

Obedience: **A poem describing your Obedience to God**

Examples: **A poem revealing the Examples you followed after**

Motivation: **A poem disclosing your true Motivation for living life**

Submit: **A poem recounting your submission to Christ**

Perspective

- **God Endured for Me:** (Romans 9:22) (1 Timothy 1:15–16)
- **God Trains His People to Hupomoné** (Heb 12:1–10, 14–15)

Obedience

- **Doing the Will of God:** Hebrews 10:36, 12:1–2
To Bear Fruit: (Luke 8:15)
- **Laying Aside My Sin:** (1 Corinthians 10:13–14) (Gen 4:4–11)

Examples

A) Jesus Christ (Matthew 4:19) (1 Peter 2:20–21)

Do you really want to follow? (Luke 9:57–59) (1 John 2:5–6)

B) Faithful Followers of Christ(2 Tim 3:10–14) (1 Cor 11:1)

Submit hupomoné to hupotássō

Submit: hupotássō; from hupó; under, and tássō, to place in order.

To place under in an orderly fashion.
