**Righteousness:** Dikaiosúnē, Just. Conformity to a just standard or to a certain set of expectations, which vary from role to role.

Righteousness is fulfillment of the expectations in any relationship, whether with God or other people. The opposite of righteous is “evil,” “lawlessness,” “wicked,” or “wrong”. - Baker encyclopedia

**Righteousness:** The state of being perfectly (100%) “right” with God

**There are two necessary prerequisites to be righteous before God**

**1. The imputation of righteousness (Rom 1:16-18, 2 Cor 5:18-21, Isaiah 45:24, Jer. 33:16, 1 Cor. 1:30)**

**2. The impartation of righteousness (1 Peter 1:14-16, 2:21-25)**
